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SUMMARY

Dr. DiCarlo is a forensic and counseling psychologist licensed in the State of Arizona. He operates a private practice in the Phoenix Metropolitan Area specializing in family court matters. Dr. DiCarlo's practice focus is on providing outcome-informed therapeutic interventions and reunification for parent-child contact problems. Dr. DiCarlo is also the co-owner and developer of Intensive Family Transformations, PLLC, Arizona's first locally-operated intensive reunification program. He also serves as an expert in the area of parent-child contact problems, parenting time, and other custody-related matters. Dr. DiCarlo strives to provide balanced evaluations in custody and parental fitness proceedings. He works effectively and compassionately within high conflict co-parenting dynamics, as well as therapeutic issues with adults, adolescents, and children. Dr. DiCarlo regularly presents to professional organizations and groups in his area of expertise and is the past President and current Vice President of the Arizona Chapter of the Association of Family & Conciliation Courts (AFCC).

Dr. DiCarlo has been appointed by the Maricopa, Pima, Coconino, and Yavapai County Superior Courts over 100 times in expert roles that include Therapeutic Interventionist (TI), Court-Appointed Behavioral Interventionist (COBI), Independent Psychological Evaluation (IPE), Comprehensive Family Evaluation (CFE) and Focused Assessment (FA)/Limited Family Assessment (LFA). On average, Dr. DiCarlo sees approximately 12 new families per year for TI/COBI work, as well as completes 5-10 custody-related evaluations or expert reports per year.
